	Chapter 8 – DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM		
 IV. DROPPING BACK THROUGH THE DEV LEVELS A. DECLARATION DATE: The SAC (State Administrative Committee) must determine prior to the beginning of the competitive year, a designated "declaration date". The program (DEV or XCEL) competed first after the "declaration" date will determine that athlete's program (DEV or XCEL) for the remainder of that season. Once a gymnast has competed in a sanctioned event past the declaration date, she may NOT drop back to a lower DEV level in the same competitive season.

- 1. Take I-64E
- 2. Take exit 261B for Hampton Roads Center Parkway E
- 3. Merge onto Hampton Roads Center Parkway and cross Armistead Avenue to enter the Boo Williams Sportsplex parking lot.

For people traveling from Suffolk, Chesapeake

- 1. Take I-664 North toward Newport News
- 2. Merge onto I-64 West via exit 1A on the Left toward Williamsburg/Richmond
- 3. Merge onto VA-134 N/MAGRUDER BLVD. via exit 262B toward NASA/Poquoson
- 4. Turn Right on Hardy Cash Drive
- 5. Turn Left on Coliseum Drive
- 6. Merge Right onto Hampton Roads Center Parkway and cross Armistead Avenue to enter the Boo Williams Sportsplex parking lot.

For people traveling from Norfolk, VA BEACH

- 1. Begin on I-64 West toward Hampton/Richmond
