<u>Entry Procedures:</u> Go to <u>www.VAUSAG.com</u>, click on VA USA Gymnastics Information tab, select VA Member Club Handbook, go to Section 5. Clubs must enter their State Meet via

the USA Gymnastics Meet Reservation System through their Club

Administration Page. *NEW 2024-2025 – Qualifying Scores must be attained

in one meet prior to State Meet AND Team Awards will be presented.

Please note the rule change as stated in **Rules and Policies 2024-2025**, page 70:

IV. DROPPING BACK THROUGH XCEL DIVISIONS

- **A. DECLARATION DATE**: The SAC (State Administrative Committee) must determine prior to the beginning of the competitive year, a designated "declaration date".
 - 1. The program (DEV or XCEL) competed first after the "declaration" date will determine that athlete's program (DEV or XCEL) for the remainder of that season.
 - 2. Once a gymnast has competed in a sanctioned event past the declaration date, she may NOT drop back to a lower XCEL division in the same competitive season.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO ALL CLUBS & COACHES:

It is imperative with the size of our VA Meet that all state entries be submitted in a timely manner to organize and inform the participating clubs as soon as possible of session assignments. Thank you for your attention in this matter. ONLY professional members who are coaching athletes who are competing in a session are allowed on the competition floor. Please plan accordingly.

Gymnasts should be entered in their respective state meets at the club's earliest opportunity to aid in planning purposes, however, gymnasts are not considered entered until payment is received. Only www.usagym.org Club Administrators will be able to submit or modify entries.

VA STATE ENTRY PROCEDURES — ALL CLUBS MUST USE THE USA GYMNASTICS MEET RESERVATION SYSTEM TO ENTER THEIR STATE MEET.

USA Gymnastics mandated that State Meet entries must be processed through the Meet Reservation System (MRS). In order to make this system work, you must keep your club roster for both gymnasts and coaches up-to-date on www.usagym.org. Invitational competition hosts are strongly encouraged to post scores to www.myUSAGym.org to facilitate reporting of qualifying scores to the State Chair.

CLUB ADMINISTRATORS HOW TO:

- Step 1: Log on to the USA Gymnastics website
- Step 2: Click on Member Services
- Step 3: Click on Club Administration link located on the left-hand side
- Step 4: From the drop click on Meet Reservations
- Step 5: Scroll to the bottom and click on Search for Meets
- Step 6: Select the Discipline Type and State
- Step 7: Select the "Virginia Xcel Silver/Gold State Championships"
- Step 8: Complete the requested information
- Step 9: Select the athletes and coaches that you wish to reserve a spot in the meet
- Step 10: Click the submit button and review the information and click submit again to finalize the reservation. Clubs are required to process all State Meet Participants (athletes and coaches) through the Meet Reservation System, by the Reservation Period Closes date posted.

Purpose of State Meets in Virginia & Culminating Competition Information:

The purpose of Virginia USA Gymnastics State Meets is to provide a culminating competition for the regular season of Virginia gymnasts who have met the qualification guidelines set forth by USA Gym State, Regional & National Committees. All Levels & Divisions are required to meet attain the required qualifying score prior to entering each Level or Division's State Meet. Individual Event, All Around and Team Awards are presented for all Levels & Divisions - See 2025 Quick View Chart. All state qualifiers who attend a state meet receive a state gift presented at the conclusion of their competitive session. To see a complete ranking of all gymnasts in each level/division and age group competing at a state meet, please refer to the VA USA Gymnastics website on the day following the last session of competition at www.VAUSAG.com. Team rankings are also available.

**Level 3, 4, 5, & 6, 7 & 8 & All Xcel Levels - Set forth by the Virginia State Administrative Committee. A Virginia State Championships Qualification Medal will be presented to all <u>Xcel Bronze & Silver and Level 3 & 4 athletes ONLY</u>. Achievement Ribbons: awarded to Levels 3, 4 and Xcel Bronze & Silver athletes only.

**Level 7 & 8 & Xcel Gold, Platinum, Diamond & Sapphire Regionals- Set forth by the Region 7 Administrative Committee.

**Level 9 & 10 State, Regionals, L9 Eastern Championships & L10 Development National Championships - Set forth by the National Administrative Committee. Prequalification Instructions can be found here: FORM 9 2025 REGIONAL PRE

- *From States Level 7, 8, 9 & 10 AND Xcel Gold, Platinum, Diamond & Sapphire qualify to their Regional Championships:
 - Qualifying guidelines from States to Regional Championships is found in USA Gym Women's Rules & Policies with details of the event qualifying requirements on www.region7usagym.com.
 - Regional Championships is the culminating event for Level 7, 8 & Xcel Gold, Platinum, Diamond and Sapphire.
 - o From Regionals Level 9 & 10 athletes qualify to their culminating Championships.
 - Level 9 USA Gymnastics East/West Championships for Level 9.
 - Level 10 USA Gymnastics Women's Development Program Championships.

Additional Information:

- **State Championships** are set up according to the USA Gymnastics Women's Rules & Policies with guidelines set forth by the National, Regional and State Administrative Committees.
- **Virginia State Meets** are USA Gymnastics Sanctioned Events and follow a Modified Capital Cup format held in outside venues organized by the VA SAC.
- ONLY professional members who are coaching and athletes competing are allowed in the competition area.
- Coaches are required to follow state meet & above professional standards (ie:apparel Chapter 1 R&P)
- ProScore is the scoring platform reporting to MeetScoresOnline.com and myUSAgym.com.
- Certified meet director, medical personnel, scorekeeper, meet referee and judges are scheduled for this event. <u>Safe</u>
 <u>Sport</u> guidelines are adhered to.
- Medical Procedures: Please follow USA Gymnastics R&P and SafeSport Requirements.
- Spectators: A gate fee for outside venues is charged. Please supervise children in attendance.
- XCEL is an alternative USA Gymnastics competitive program offering individual flexibility to coaches and gymnasts. The goal of XCEL is to provide gymnasts of varying abilities and commitment levels the opportunity for a rewarding gymnastics experience in the state of Virginia and Region 7.
- Inquiries & Video Review: Coaches are responsible for reviewing proper inquiry guidelines prior to the state meet and
 how to properly complete an inquiry form to best serve your athletes. Video Review Requirements should be reviewed.
